We've come a long way, Baby!

Since the original bid was awarded on September 2, 2005
(3 days into Katrina) we now have:

- Over 500,000 items covered under contract
- 77 vendors awarded contracts.
- A "nominal" 26 states signed on to use one or more of the contractors
- Our contractors have been used to weather Katrina, floods in Western NYS, manhunts for cop killers, and for the preparation for disaster response- either manmade or natural

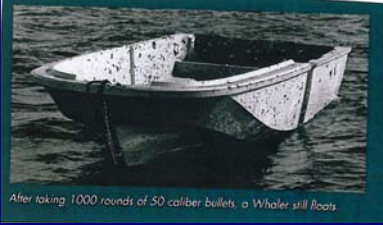


Combat proven, all-terrain tactical utility vehicle
