N1-NASPO Coop Lab Supply Contracts:

The NASPO Cooperative Committee, with the concurrence of the WSCA and Southern Region directors, have directed the resolicitation of the two laboratory supply contracts as a single, combined NASPO-wide cooperative contract.

The new contract will be **N1-NASPO Coop Lab Supply Contracts** and will be led by Idaho. It will be built on the current N1-HELP contract led by Arkansas and the W8-WSCA Lab Supply contract led by Idaho. The new contract will be structured and based on our combined experience since 2003 on contracting for this group of commodities.

This will be a limited multiple award contract. Responders will be able to limit their area of responsibility by a number of factors, including by state or groups of states.

A sourcing team has already been organized, representing six states. The sourcing team has started meeting and will continue to meet regularly.

Currently, the intent is to host a pre-proposal meeting the week of **February 21, 2010** (location to be determined). At this meeting an overview of the proposed solicitation will be presented. Our hope is that interested parties will attend and provide us with feedback about the proposed solicitation in writing by early in March.

Our intent is to release the solicitation in **April, 2010** and have responses due by **May 2, 2010**. We intend to have the new contract ready for use (Master Price Agreements negotiated and signed) by **July 1, 2010**.
