Scope: All State of New Mexico agencies, commissions, institutions, political subdivisions and local public bodies allowed by law (i.e. prosecutors and courts in counties, cities, municipalities, etc.) may purchase the products and services available in the NASPO Master Price Agreement (Contract No. B26054)."

- Changes:** West will remit to the State of New Mexico Contract Manager an Administrative Fee in the amount of one percent (1%) of all sales for New Mexico State and Local Public Bodies from this contract. Checks should be made payable to the State of New Mexico.

- Service and supplies billings;



Terms and conditions inconsistent with, or contrary to the terms and conditions of this Addendum and the Master Price Agreement, together with its exhibits, shall not be added to or incorporated into this Addendum or the Master Price Agreement and its exhibits, by any subsequent purchase order or otherwise, and any such attempts to add or incorporate such terms and conditions are hereby rejected. The terms and conditions of this Addendum and the Master Price Agreement and its exhibits shall prevail and govern in the case of any such inconsistent or additional terms.
- 6. **Westlaw Order Forms:** The State of New Mexico has reviewed West's applicable Order Forms and hereby incorporates these documents into the New Mexico Participating Addendum.
- 7. **Cancellation of the Participating Addendum:** At the time of termination or expiration of a Participating Addendum, any existing multi-year agreement between the Contract Vendor and a Participating Agency as allowed under the Price Schedules, will remain in effect and continue to exist under the terms and conditions of the Master Price Agreement until the term expires as set forth in that multi-year agreement.
