Professional Development - Create and deliver innovative research, education and learning opportunities.

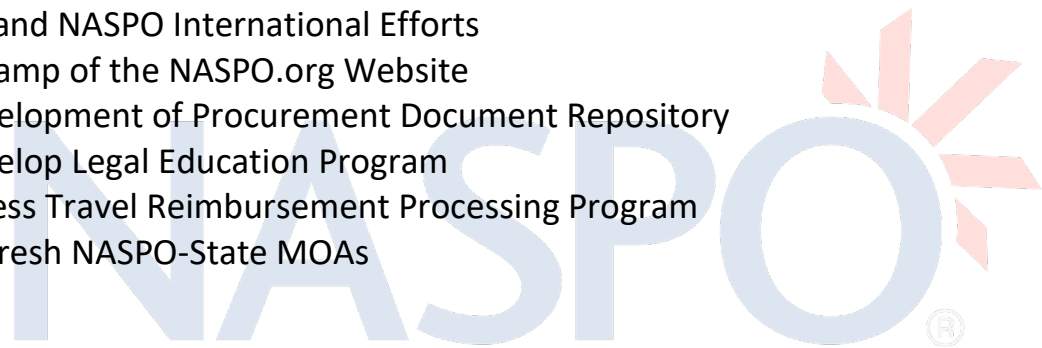
